



## GUEST ARRIVAL PROCEDURE

Effective from March 13th, 2022, the following changes have been brought regarding the PCR requirements:

- I. Travelers are NO LONGER required to present a PCR test result upon arrival to the Maldives.

Common requirements for all travelers;

- I. All arriving and departing passengers via airports and seaports (including children) are required to complete the Traveler Health Declaration form via IMUGA ([imuga.immigration.gov.mv](http://imuga.immigration.gov.mv)) within 48 hours, prior to the departure.
- II. Relax knowing your health and wellbeing is our utmost concern. Guests arriving at Amilla must fill in a Health Declaration Form, and their temperature is taken with a no-touch thermometer. Additionally, all team members returning to Amilla are tested. Amilla is conducting random sampling of 50 team members per week; focusing on key team members in the Kids' Club, F&B and those with direct guest contact to keep our island safe.
- III. For those international departures requiring PCR tests: We can assist with such requests at an offsite location, at a charge USD \$125 per person, subject to 10% service charge and 12% goods and service tax. This test would be validated by a laboratory that is accredited by the Health Protection Agency of the Maldives.
